### 3. Links between Dunsfold Park links, including Alfold and Wey & Arun Canal

HN has contacted the landowner of the Holdhurst Estate to seek a meeting with regard to an improved route across his land to make a more direct route from Dunsfold Park to Cranleigh.

CP has continued to ask Dunsfold Park for a meeting to discuss the routes between the site and surrounding villages.

\* CP to ask Tony Ford for a meeting to discuss the planning application for the new road bridge on Dunsfold Road (as well as other matters regarding the WACT)

\* CP - to contact Martin Bamford with regard to a link through Knowle Park to connect with onward routes towards Holdhurst and Dunsfold Park.

### 4. Godalming-Guildford Greenway

No update provided in the meeting as most of the representatives were already aware of the latest developments.

The Ockford Park development has been given planning permission. This will yield significant S106 revenues for transport, including ~£800k for sustainable transport schemes and improvements to the A3100 corridor.

CP met with Cllr Rivers, Richard Cooper (SCC) and Adrian Selby (SCC) in Oct 2018 to discuss how these funds could support the development of the Greenway, as well as other schemes in Godalming.

## **5. Other area schemes**

Cranleigh - huge resources are available as discussed previously, particularly for the Elmbridge Road bridge.

Such a large scheme (£3.3m in S106 revenue across 6 developments) must also include provision to improve access to Cranleigh from the west, either alongside Elmbridge Road, or parallel provision and connecting to the Knowle Park Initiative site. This scheme would be split across two parishes - Alfold to the west and Cranleigh to the east.

\* CP to contact Cranleigh Parish Council to discuss the proposed schemes in Cranleigh.

## **6. AOB**

RS/MB - WBC are interested in formalising a link from the centre of Bramley to the Downs Link. Presently this is a dirt track with no legal access.
